SPEAKER NICHOL: That is right.

SENATOR VICKERS: Why don't you go ahead with the roll call vote in reverse order then.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Roll call vote in the reverse order and we are voting on the Vickers amendment to the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 69 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment fails. Do you have another amendment, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp. The call is raised.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, I have already explained the bill. I have got some additional amendments but I want to make sure everybody is coordinated on them and they all have the same interpretation of them before I would offer them so I am going to hold off on those assuming the bill advances to Select File and I would ask the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Harris, on the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR HARRIS: Mr. Speaker, I also urge the advancement of the bill. I think perhaps on Select File we can deal with this
