

and other types of lenders are going to be here. The farm credit system was ruined long before 999. The falling land prices occurred long before 999. There were farmers who could not get loans before 999, and some of those whose credit will not be improved by the changing of this bill the way the lenders want it, they will still not be able to get loans. So, what I hope we can do is go a step at a time and look at what we can do, even if it is a small amount to alleviate the misery of the people that will surely come, and I don't believe it is going to hurt the lenders or the economy of this state any worse than it is already hurt. My time is up, Mr. Chairman, so I will stop here.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. Senator Lundy.

SENATOR LUNDY: Mr. Speaker, I call the question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Debate has ceased. Senator Hoagland, do you wish to close on the committee amendments?

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Yes, I will waive closing on the committee amendments, Mr. Speaker. I think everything has been said that needs to be said. Senator Rod Johnson has adopted them. The lenders have no objections to them. I will reserve comment on some of the aspects of Senator DeCamp's speech. I think he is inaccurate with respect to this bill in some respects but I won't bother the Legislature with that before lunch. I simply move the adoption of the committee amendments at this time.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. Before we recess for lunch, Mr. Clerk, do you have anything you wish to put in?
