SENATOR LUNDY: Mr. Speaker, I move that we now proceed to move LB 1 to E & R.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor...the motion is to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.
