SENATOR DECAMP: Can we not deal with that question until we get to the next amendment?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Well, I guess we could. But I just...it seems to me that it is part and parcel of what we are discussing at this time.

SENATOR DECAMP: It is part and parcel.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I think if you adopt this amendment we just as well build the case as we go, had we not?

SENATOR DECAMP: Sure.

SENATOR SCHMIT: It is your intent, is it not, Senator DeCamp, and I believe the intent of this Legislature that we move toward a central filing system...

SENATOR DECAMP: That is correct.

SENATOR SCHMIT: ...as the only system of notification in this state, and we are not going to be harassed or hampered by the other notification system.

SENATOR DECAMP: Well, Senator Schmit, if this were a round room, you couldn't corner me on that. But this is not a round room. So, yes, it is my intent and, no, that is not what we are doing.
