We are not going to do that to them. Instead we are going to give them a little notice that if you want that done, if you want to be treated that way then jump through a hoop to do it. I would suggest to those of you that aren't involved in the business of agriculture you would not like that very much if your credit cards were treated that way, or if your other credit that you've got with the stores that you do business were treated that way. Senator DeCamp seems to think that because it is on a five year, and I don't know exactly how a five year rotation works into this, I didn't realize that financial statements or security agreements were necessarily for five years at a shot. But it seems to me that once you are able to pay off your debts, once you are able to say that what I've got now is mine, you ought to have the ability, very easily, without you having to do something yourself, to have that computer system, that we are creating, recognize that. Now, if that computer is going to be so difficult to punch that kind of information in, it seems to me it is going to be very difficult then to punch it in when I go in and borrow another 25,000.
