

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 89-90 of the Legislative Journal.) 10 ayes, 30 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. The call is raised. Do you have anything else on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp, did you wish to move for the advancement of the bill? Okay, Senator DeCamp moves the advancement of the bill. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Move on to LB 3E. Where are we, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 3E, I have no E & R amendments, I do, however, have a series of other amendments. The first amendment I have Mr. President to the bill is by Senator DeCamp. Senator DeCamp's amendment is found on page 74 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator DeCamp wishes to withdraw that amendment. The next amendment I have to the bill is by Senator John DeCamp, it is found on page 75 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator John DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President and members, I have not done any vote counting or worked this amendment at all. This amendment simply would go back and establish the law that was in existence before LB 999. I don't want to take a lot of time but I would like to try to prove my case and set in the record some things that I think are going to show up later. And, for those of you who have doubts because this is a complicated area, I might just remind you that I did try to kill this bill or stop it about two or three times and predicted that it would do exactly what it did, shut off credit, and I predicted as you recall that you would be back here in a special session forced to deal with it, and I suggested that as a result of not passing or I should say as a result of the Governor vetoing, the same result would occur and it is here. I would like to now suggest and submit to you and try to offer you proof that LB 3 will in fact guarantee to shut off credit to any beginning true family farmer. I repeat, I believe that it will absolutely shut off any reasonable credit
