Government Committee heard, in public testimony, the credentials of various members of the State Personnel Board, Lovie Broadus and Steven Danahy. SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, yesterday during the lunch hour we had a hearing to review the Governor's five appointments to the Crime Victims Reparations Committee. The names of the individuals nominated are set out on page 95 of the Journal.
