SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, we are, Mr. President. The Public Works Committee met yesterday noon and heard Mr. James L. Eatmon of Kimball, Nebraska; Mr. Harold C. Tremain of Sidney, Nebraska, as the Governor's nominees to the Oil and Gas Commission. The committee voted unanimously in support of those nominations and recommended them to the full Legislature for your approval. We also heard the nominations of Mr. Jim Earp of Omaha, Mr. Clifford E. Langel, and Mr. P.J. Morgan of Omaha to the Motor Vehicle Licensing Board. The committee would like to recommend those for appointment to the Safety Center Advisory Council. For the Coordinating Commission on Postsecondary Education, Mr. Eric Seacrest, and Mrs. Beth Klosterman. The committee would like to recommend and move that these people all be confirmed.
