SENATOR VICKERS: With your approval, yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, yes. Any further discussion on the three committee reports as explained by Senator Vickers? If not, the question is the adoption of the report. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the confirmation reports.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely, are you prepared on the Health and Welfare Committee's report?

CLERK: Mr. President, I might point out that I believe copies of Senator Wesely's report have been distributed to the membership, and you will find them on the desk.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members, there is a copy on your desk, if you just look. It's a letter to Patrick. It does list the different appointees. Because you don't have it in your Journal, I will just read them to you. The first deals with the Nebraska Child Abuse Prevention Fund Board. That is the board to implement LB 333, the child abuse trust fund bill. Jessie Rasmussen, John Dudley, Marietta Sims, Kathy Campbell, Deane Finnegan, Dr. Tom Tonneges, and Karen Authier are recommended for that. The Director of DPI, Dale Johnson, is recommended to the State Board of Health; Arlene Rhodes, Larry Bartels, Dr. Craig Nelson, James Kenney, Dr. Jeanette Masek, Janet Coleman; the Rural Health Manpower Commission, Marcia Goering, Dr. Judy Butler, Dr. L.C. Potts, Dr. Perlita Narvaez, and Jean Garten. Two individuals, who were up for consideration on the Foster Care Review Board, at the hearing withdrew their names and have resigned from those positions. So they are not included in this. But the others that we heard yesterday are recommended for approval.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the committee report? If not, the question is the adoption of the committee report. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. As I understand it, we have three other committee reports to consider, but they will not be considered at this time, Miscellaneous Subjects is not in, and Ag Committee.
