CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The resolution is adopted. We'll move to Final Reading, LB 2E. Would you please return to your seats and be seated. Unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. (Gavel.) Would you please be seated in your regular station so we can continue with Final Reading. One more time, please return to your desks so that we can...please return to your seats so we can begin. As soon as you all return to your seats, we will begin. Thank you. LB 2 with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: (Read LB 2 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 2 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 114 of the Legislative Journal.) 49 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to pass LB 2, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 2 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 1 with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: (Read LB 1 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted that care to? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 115 of the Legislative Journal.) 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 1 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 3 with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Chambers would move to return LB 3 to Select File for a specific amendment, that amendment being to strike the DeCamp amendment.
