SPEAKER NICHOL:      Let's go back to the confirmation reports. Mr. Clerk, which one first?

CLERK:      Mr. President, the first report I have is by the Agriculture and Environment Committee. It is offered by Senator Rod Johnson as Chair.

SPEAKER NICHOL:      Senator Rod Johnson, please.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON:      Mr. President, we have...the Agriculture Committee met yesterday and put out three names for the Legislature to consider. CLERK:      35 ayes, Mr. President, 0 nays on adoption of the Agriculture and Environment confirmation report.

SPEAKER NICHOL:      The confirmation report is accepted.

CLERK:      Mr. President, Senator Hefner, Chair of the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee, would move to adopt the confirmation report.
