To appropriate funds for the necessary expenses of the extraordinary session hearing called. I direct that all members of the Legislature of the State of Nebraska be notified of the convening of this extraordinary session by sending to each of them a copy of this Proclamation in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Nebraska to be affixed this 3rd day of December, 1986, (signed) Bob Kerrey, Governor."

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Cal Carsten, I'd call on you, please, for an official meeting.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature...

SPEAKER NICHOL: (Gavel.) Excuse me, Senator Carsten, (gavel) may we please have your attention. Senator Cal Carsten will have a few words for you.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I would move the following officers be elected to serve for the Eighty-Ninth Legislature, Fourth Special Session: Patrick J. O'Donnell for Clerk of the Legislature; Richard Brown, Assistant Clerk of the Legislature; Dr. Robert E. Palmer Chaplain-Coordinator; and Karl Kamprath, Sergeant-at-Arms. I would so move.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are approved. Senator John DeCamp, please.

SENATOR DECAMP: I move we adjourn sine...no, just jesting. I move that the President appoint a committee of five to notify the Governor that the Legislature is now convened, organized and ready for the transaction of business and to return with any message the Governor may have for this, the Fourth Special Session of the Eighty-Ninth Legislature.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, you've heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is adopted. I would appoint Senator Bernice Labeledz, Senator Hoagland, Senator DeCamp, Senator Eret and Senator Sieck to act as a committee to escort the Governor to the podium.
