

introduced on December 5 of this year. It was referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Cal Carsten, please.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I would move for the advancement of LB 3. You will note on the fiscal attachment to the bill that we have a total of 47,560 for this special session. That breakdown, if you would like to have it, is for the legislative services, the 19,006 is per diem for us to attend. The 17,900 is for people and printing for the session. And the 10 is, of course, a little higher than what our appropriation was for the last special session. But, here again, it's basically people. We did not have as much time, or the Revisor did not have as much time in advance notice to do the work so people and Data Processing was brought in to get this job done. Also, envision that under the circumstances and the basic reason for the call, there may very well be added workload before the bill if, indeed, it is finally passed. So I would move for the advancement of the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion and that is to advance the bill from General to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill to E & R for Initial.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. We will take up LB 1, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, before we proceed, I have received a report from the Appropriations Committee reporting LB 1 to General File with committee amendments attached. Pursuant to that, LB 1 was a bill introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced, Mr. President, on December 5 of this year. It was referred to the Appropriations Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are Appropriations Committee amendments pending. I might indicate, Mr. President, that copies of the Appropriations Committee amendments are being passed out at this time.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The Chair recognizes the Chairman of Appropriations, Senator Warner. Do you wish to take up the amendments first or do you wish to talk about the bill? All
