

have had a request to also separate out from the committee amendments the issue of aid to technical community colleges.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Now, since we have a request to separate out those three things, which would be item "D" on your special session report as put out by Senator Warner, we will be talking about...Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, those items are not in the committee amendments. They are already in the bill, so whoever wishes to do that would have to have an amendment to strike from the bill the provisions for those reductions, and that will come after the committee amendment is done because we don't touch them. I should correct...the committee amendment would only be where the handwritten numbers and the printed numbers are different and I didn't make that clear. I apologize. Like on the first one, Mental Retardation, you see the bill as drafted is a \$635,067 reduction and the committee amendment is for three...only a 300,000. The next one, 309 Task Force, the Governor's is 500,000. We made no change, so that would not be a part of the committee amendment because the bill is unchanged.

SPEAKER NICHOL: So what you are saying is that where those numbers are the same, we are not discussing those at this time. Those items are...

SENATOR WARNER: Yes. No, those amendments are to the bill, not to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Those items that are different in the '86-87 column and those written in by pen, those are the items that we are discussing now.

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes. All right. Thank you. Senator Schmit, did you wish to speak on this?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, Mr. President, I have a question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Knowing the final item on the Revenue Department, Mr. President, I would like to ask Senator Warner a question, if he would yield, please.
