

SENATOR WARNER: The whole section of roads?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR WARNER: I move the approval. The only thing that you're changing is not the total dollar amount but the cash flow on those buses which would be 400,000 for this fiscal year and the following fiscal year, rather than all in one, because the cash flow doesn't adjust...doesn't affect the total picture of revenue and expenditures.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of that portion of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: That portion of the committee amendments is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the final portion of the committee amendments relates to Section 10, relating to the University of Nebraska.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Chambers, please.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I want to try to make it as clear as I possibly can what it is I am asking you to vote on. So if you will take the white packet of committee amendments and turn to page 11 and look at line 19, my amendment, in line 19, would change that amount \$1,538,000 and small change, it would raise that amount by \$100,000, so that it would read, 1,638,000 plus. If you look at the sheet that Senator Warner handed out which gives a listing by number of the items to be dealt with by the committee amendment, there are two of them that are involved in what I am doing. In Section (a), it would be number 6, Scottsbluff nursing program; and in Section (c) it would be number 10, the University budget. The way this item was dealt with was to reduce the University budget by \$100,000 to show that that \$100,000 cut in the original bill would be restored. What I want us to do is look at the policy which is being adopted by the budget committee and which the Legislature is being asked to go along with. The Governor's proposal was to eliminate that \$100,000. What the budget committee decided to do was not eliminate it. So to
