

in the committee amendment which would keep the \$100,000. If you vote no, you don't add the committee amendment and we take away the \$100,000 with a no vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Call the roll, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 21-22 of the Legislative Journal.) 20 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of that amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment fails. Do you have anything else?

CLERK: I have other amendments to the bill, Mr. President. Mr. President, right before that, if I might, an item to read in. Your committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 3 to Select File. That is signed by Senator Hall as Enrollment and Review Chair.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment to the bill...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, we are now through with committee amendments. Did you want to say something about the bill now with the committee amendments attached? All right, then we'll go into other amendments at this time. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Haberman would move to amend the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Haberman, please.

CLERK: Senator, these are the amendments you offered last Friday. The first amendment I have is from you to strike Section 14 from the bill. There were four, Senator. All right. Mr. President, Senator Haberman would move to amend the bill. Senator Haberman's amendment is on page 10. This is amendment number four, Senator, relating to the Department of Roads. You want to withdraw that one as well? The next amendment I have, Mr. President, is by Senators Landis, Chambers and Schmit. (See pages 22-23 of the Legislative Journal.)
