

SENATOR CARSTEN: Thank you. Senator Hoagland, please.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Question.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Debate has ceased. Senator Schmit, would you like to close on your....

SENATOR SCHMIT: No closing, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall the Schmit amendment be adopted? All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted who care to do so? Have you all voted? Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I want a call of the house and a record vote, please. Let's have a roll call vote.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The house is under call. All those senators who are within the sound of my voice and are not in the Chamber, please return to your chairs and register your presence, please. Senator Baack, Senator Higgins, Senator Landis, Senator Bill Nichol, Senator Wesely. There he is. We are short Senator Landis, Senator Nichol, and Senator Baack. Nichol and Landis are the only two that aren't.... We are short two, Senator Schmit, Senator Nichol and Senator Landis. Do you want to proceed, or do you want to wait on them?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Why don't we start, Mr. President, in reverse order. Maybe by that time they might be here.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, roll call vote has been requested in reverse order. Would you call the roll, please, Mr. Clerk.
