

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Warner, what would you like to do with LB 1?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that the bill be advanced to E & R Review.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Motion is to advance LB 1 to E & R Initial. Is there any discussion? If not, all those in favor of advancing LB 1 to E & R initial will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 1 to E & R Initial as amended. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted? Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I guess, Mr. President, I need to ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote, I guess.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The house is under call. All senators please take your seats and register your presence. All unauthorized personnel will please leave the floor. Those senators who are within the sound of my voice, please return to the Chamber and register your presence. Senator Goodrich. Senator Peterson. Here is Senator Goodrich. Senator Peterson is the only other one? Senator Warner, do you want to take call ins? You want a roll call. I think he asked for a roll call vote.

SENATOR WARNER: That's probably faster.

SENATOR CARSTEN: I think Senator Peterson is the only one that we are waiting on, Senator Warner. Do you want to proceed? Proceed with the roll call on the advancement of LB 1, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 43 of the Legislative Journal.) 33 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: LB 1 is advanced to E & R Initial. Do you have anything to read in, Mr. Clerk?
