SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall LB 2 be advanced to E & R Initial? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: LB 2 has been advanced to E & R Initial, as amended. That is all we have on General File, right?

CLERK: On General File, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Now, we will move to Select File. LB 3, is it?

CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 3 I have no Enrollment and Review amendments, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: I would move that LB 3 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossing.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Any discussion on the advancement of LB 3? If not, all those in favor of advancing LB 3 from Select File will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Say aye. Those opposed no. Motion is carried. Do you have something to read in, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and reviewed LB 1 and recommend that same be placed on Select File with Enrollment and Review amendments attached. That is signed by Senator Hall. Senator Schmit has amendments to LB 1. Senator DeCamp has amendments to LB 1 to be printed. (See pages 45-46 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, new resolution offered by Senator Vickers, LR 2. (Read LR 2 for the first time. See pages 46-47 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Chambers would offer...Senator Chambers has amendments to be printed to LB 1, Mr. President. I believe that is all that I have. (See page 47 of the Journal.)
