

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, thank you. Senator Schmit, would you like to close? Excuse me, another light just came on. Senator Warner, please, on the Schmit amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, it just occurred to me listening to Senator Schmit, my concern was lapsing this and spending it, it just occurred to me we already have, and since we've already spent the 150,000 by reducing 40,000 of lapse to the General Fund from the Department of Revenue and we've added 100,000 to the cuts for the nursing school at Scottsbluff, it would be...we can only spend it once and it's now spent so I now support the amendment to reduce LB 835 by 150,000 and I truly hope that those of you who are convinced that 835 need no funds are correct. And you know we can certainly, if we get any requests for funds, why we will, next year we can indicate that the judgment was now that it was not needed and we don't think it is going to be needed no matter what happens. So I see no problem. The money is gone. It would be a good idea to lapse this there, but please keep in mind, you're not going to spend it again. We already have.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Thank you. Senator Schmit, would you like to close on your amendment now then?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I think Senator Warner has said it very well. I think we do have \$10,000 left to bounce around there that someone might be able to glom onto, but in the absence of that I ask you to support the amendment and lapse these funds. Thank you very much.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall the Schmit amendment to LB 1 be adopted? All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I'd like to have a call of the house and call in votes, please.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor of going under call will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The house is under call. All senators will please return to their chairs, register their presence.
