The amendment that I am offering is to restore the \$9,372 to Environmental Control.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Chambers, is that your opening and closing? There are no other speakers. That being the case, the question is, shall this amendment from Senator Chambers be adopted to LB 1. All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Have all of you that are here voted? Go ahead. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 58-59 of the Legislative Journal.) 7 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The amendment is not adopted. Do you have anything more on it?

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment...yes, sir, I do...is by Senator Sieck. (See Sieck amendment found on page 59 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Sieck, on your amendment to LB 1, please.

SENATOR SIECK: Mr. President, members of the body, there was some terrific speeches made here by Senator Chambers and Senator Miller and they were very true, and I had to hold myself from out toning them and talking about them. The last one, environments, is something the Legislature is going to face this coming year, and I felt that would be the time to do it. Now, as you all know, I am going into that field on environment. I had to work on it and I've worked on it in this Legislature, but why I am saying this is because I feel that these two gentlemen are right on mark, and I feel the cause that I am going to represent to you is of the same nature. I am going to try to prove to you that the cut will cost the State of Nebraska money. Even though some of the cut was restored from the original, I still feel that we cannot do enough in this particular area and it is going to cost us money if we do not do it. I know of families who are out there, and I can use myself as an example,
