

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a priority motion.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. Clerk, you say we have a priority motion?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, Senator Lynch would move that this Legislature adjourn sine die.

SPEAKER NICHOL: No discussion on this. The motion is to adjourn sine die. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please. A roll call vote has been asked for. Do you want a call of the house? Okay, the question is, shall the house go under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 1 nay to go under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Will you please indicate your presence. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Thank you. Senator Hartnett, Senator Harris, Senator Baack, Senator Scofield, Senator Schmit. We're looking for Senator Schmit and Senator Scofield. Now we are looking for Senator Schmit. Okay, we're all here. The question is the motion to adjourn sine die and was a roll call asked for? Yes. Okay, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on page 64 of the Legislative Journal.) 17 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to sine die.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Do you have anything else, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have with respect to LB 1 is an amendment by Senator Pappas.

CLERK: And Senator Wesely.
