CLERK: Yes, sir. (Read LB 3 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 3 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Have you all voted. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 78 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 3 passes with the emergency clause attached. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign, LB 1, LB 2, and LB 3. Do you have anything else, Mr. Clerk?
