AN ACT relating to crimes and punishments; to amend section 28-801, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change a provision relating to prostitution; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 28-801, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

28-801. (1) Any person who performs, offers, or agrees to perform any act of sexual penetration, as defined in subdivision (5) (6) of section 28-318, with any person not his or her spouse in exchange for money or other thing of value commits prostitution.

Any person violating this section shall be issued a citation in lieu of arrest pursuant to sections 29-422 to 29-429.

(2) Prostitution is a Class V misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. That original section 28-801, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
