AN ACT relating to schools; to amend section 79-2504, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change provisions relating to representation on a commission as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 79-2504, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

79-2504. The provisions of Article III, SECTION A., of the Compact for Education notwithstanding, the members of the Education Commission of the states representing this state shall consist of the Governor, four three members of the Legislature selected by the Executive Board of the Legislature Council, and two three members appointed by the Governor. Of the three members appointed by the Governor one member shall be a member of a school board or board of education of a Class II, III, IV, V, or VI school district or an appointed representative of a state association of school boards or boards of education representing such districts.

Sec. 2. That original section 79-2504, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
