LEGISLATIVE BILL 810

Approved by the Governor February 3, 1988

AN ACT relating to the Department of Public Institutions; to amend sections 83-211 and 83-212, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to eliminate a provision relating to an appeal; to redefine a term; to eliminate references to a section that was repealed in 1976; and to repeal the original sections, and section 83-211.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943. Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 83-211, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

83-211. The Department of Public Institutions shall have power in each instance (1) to establish standards of qualification for personnel employed in carrying out the previsions of sections 83-210.01 to 83-210.07, and (2) to employ necessary field agents, teachers, and other personnel in accordance with such standards and fix their compensation. 7 and (3) to employ necessary elerical help and incur necessary expenses in carrying out the provisions of section 83-210-

Sec. 2. That section 83-212, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

83-212. The term blind as used in sections 83-210 and 83-211 programs administered by the Department of Public Institutions shall include all persons whose sight is so defective as to seriously limit their ability to engage in the ordinary vocations and activities of life.

Sec. 3. That original sections 83-211 and 83-212, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and also section 83-211.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
