## LEGISLATIVE BILL 548

## Approved by the Governor April 20, 1989

Introduced by Conway, 17; Scofield, 49; Hefner, 19

AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Pure Food Act; to amend sections 81-216.01 and 81-216.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to exempt bed and breakfast establishments from the act; to define a term; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The Nebraska Pure Food Act shall not apply to bed and breakfast establishments.

Sec. 2. Bed and breakfast establishment shall mean any place of lodging that provides rented rooms to ten or fewer people, that is the personal residence of the owner, that is occupied by the owner at the time of rental, and in which the only meal served to renters is breakfast.

Sec. 3. That section 81-216.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

81-216.01. Sections 81-216.01 to 81-216.37and sections 1 and 2 of this act and the provisions of the Food Service Code, Retail Food Code, Food Salvage Code, Food Vending Code, and Food Processing and Storage Code, adopted by reference in sections 81-216.15 to 81-216.19 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Pure Food Act.

Sec. 4. That section 81-216.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

81-216.02. For purposes of sections 81-216-01to 81-216-37 the Nebraska Pure Food Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the definitions found in sections 81-216.03 to 81-216.14 and section 2 of this act shall be used. In addition, the definitions found in the codes adopted by reference in sections 81-216.15to 81-216.19 shall be used.

Sec. 5. That original sections 81-216.01 and 81-216.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
