PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Okay, we now will proceed with the vote on the motion to refer LR 3 to committee. All those in favor please vote aye, all those opposed please vote nay. Okay, Mr. Clerk, please record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to refer the resolution.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The motion to refer passes. Mr. Clerk, we will proceed to go to General File.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 1, introduced by the Executive Board, a Revisor's bill. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10 of this year, referred directly to General File, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: I recognize Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, as you know, these are Revisor statute bills which are corrections of past errors that Bill Drafting has found, as required under statute, during the last year, or they are legislation that is deemed to be obsolete. Most frequently those that are obsolete is because there was a date on which certain action was to occur. Once you are past that date, of course, why then the statute is no longer pertinent, no longer is required to be maintained. And, by tradition, if not rule, I do not recall these bills are not used as vehicles for any substantive legislation. The only amendments would be if there are errors that have been discovered during the process that need to be corrected. LB 1, and I'm not going to spend a lot of time. You have had passed out to you, last night, a description of each of the bills and their contents. So, I will just briefly touch on them. LB 1, as indicated, eliminates the references to justice courts and justice's of the peace courts that still remain some places in the statutes. And those became obsolete, obviously, with the court system that was established in 1972. With that, I'd move the bill be advanced to E & R.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Okay. Thank you, Senator Warner. Senator Warner, do you have any closing comments? We will proceed then to vote on the motion to advance to E & R on LB 1. All those in favor please vote aye, all those opposed please vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record the vote.
