SENATOR HALL: So if I were to request from the Clerk that I would like one of those sent to me when the report is printed each month, and then once during the interim, I'd be able to still receive that?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, I am told that the estimate...it was not in my head, is between 1,500 and 2,000 dollars a year...

SENATOR HALL: Thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: ...saving.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Would anyone else care to address the amendment? Senator Warner, would you like to close on the amendment? Senator Warner waives closing. All in favor of the amendment vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: The amendment is adopted. Senator Warner, on the bill.

SENATOR WARNER: I'd just put in a motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Seeing no other lights, Senator Warner moves the advancement of the bill. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 220.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: The bill advances. On to LB 22.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 22 introduced by Senators Coordsen and Haberman. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 10, referred to the Government Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending by the Government Committee, Mr. President. (See AM0031 on page 426 of the Legislative Journal.)
