

February 14, 1991 LB 21, 47, 171

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 47.

PRESIDENT MOUL: All those in favor of the motion to adopt the E & R amendments please say aye. Opposed nay. Motion is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on that bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 47 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: All those in favor of the motion to advance LB 47 please say aye. Opposed nay. Motion is adopted and LB 47 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 171.

CLERK: LB 171, Senator, has no amendments pending.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 171 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: All those in favor of the motion to advance LB 171 please say aye. Opposed nay. Motion is adopted and LB 171 is advanced. Thank you, Senator Will. We will not proceed to General File, LB 21.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 21 has been discussed by the Legislature on two occasions. There was pending an amendment by Senator Beutler. However, I do have a priority motion. Senator Coordsen, as introduced, would move to bracket LB 21 until January 1, 1992.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. I have had conversations with Senator Rod Johnson, Chairman of the Natural Resources Committee, and it is his opinion, that in view of other water issues that are being addressed by the Natural Resources Committee, that they would like to possibly make LB 21 part of those, of the total package
