PRESIDENT MOUL: Senators are requested to return to their seats and check in. Senators, please check in. Senator Wickersham, Senator Landis, Senator Robinson, Senator Elmer, Senator Morrissey. We're looking for Senator Elmer and Senator Morrissey. We will proceed with the roll call vote.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 775 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 24 nays.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Landis. The vote is 24-24, and the motion fails. We are on Select File. Okay, Senator Coordsen, would you wish to be recognized.

SENATOR COORSEEN: Move to readvance.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Motion is to readvance to Final. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. Motion is approved. We will proceed with Final Reading on this bill, LB 20E. Would the senators please return to their seats. Thank you, senators. We will now proceed with...before we proceed with the Final Reading, I will urge the people who are seated in the balconies not to lean over them. We don't want the risk of somebody falling. Okay, we'll proceed with Final Reading on LB 20.

CLERK: (Read LB 20 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of law relating to procedure having been adhered to, the question is, shall LB 20 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 776 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 7 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Madam President.
