CLERK:      Mr. President, LB 333, I do have E & R amendments  
pending, Senator.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R  
amendments to LB 333.

SPEAKER BAACK:      You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R  
amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are  
adopted.

CLERK:      Mr. President, Senator Abboud would move to amend.  
(Abboud amendment appears on pages 1171-72 of the Legislative  
Journal.)

SENATOR ABBOUD:      Yes, Mr. President, colleagues, my amendment  
provides that sales of motor vehicles, at the wholesale level,  
provide that the following information would be on a windshield  
of the particular car that's being sold...car or trailer sold at  
an auction. The information that would be on there would be the  
vehicle make, model, year, mileage, vehicle identification  
number, statement as to title availability for inspection or  
transfer, and whether the sale of the vehicle is subject to  
warranty provisions. This is a sale at a...at the wholesale  
level, at an auto auction. The bill is...or the amendment is  
the same as the bill, as amended, in LB 807, advanced  
unanimously out of the Transportation Committee. That's  
about...I'll be happy to answer any questions with this  
particular amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK:      Thank you, Senator Abboud. We'll now go to  
Senator Morrissey.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. I just  
rise to say that I consider this a friendly amendment, and I  
think it's something that needs to be addressed. And I have no  
problem with Senator Abboud amending this onto the bill. Thank  
you.
