SENATOR WITHEM: Okay. There are provisions in our rules to maybe put people under call, but that would take a formal vote. Thank you very much.

SPEAKER BAACK: That is correct. We're looking for Senator Ashford. Senator Ashford is here. All members who are not excused are here, so we will proceed with a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1339 of the Legislative Journal.) 15 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, on the bracket motion.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion to bracket fails and we are back on the amendment by Senator Rod Johnson. The call is raised. Is there anyone wishing to discuss the amendment by Senator Rod Johnson? Senator Morrissey, did you wish to discuss the amendment?

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Yes, I just urge you to...oh, this is the amendment?

SPEAKER BAACK: This is the amendment, yes.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: I will waive. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Anyone else wishing to discuss the amendment by Senator Rod Johnson? Seeing no one, Senator Rod Johnson, do you wish to close?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Yes, just quickly to refresh the body's memory, this amendment states that only if all of the other requirements necessary for licensure are met will the actual transfer take place, that is the last procedure that would take place before the site would be licensed is the...after it's licensed would be the transfer of the property. There is only one license issued and that is issued jointly by both the Department of Health and the DEC. That was through a memorandum that they sent to us. So there is not separate license for transportation, separate license for storage, separate license
