

family at all and you can still have the abortion. What this amendment would say is, before you can have the abortion we want you to communicate with an adult family member, simply communicate. And by the way, if you don't want to, there is a bypass, and personally, I don't see any real problem with that. There is a problem if you say two parents rather than one, and I understand that, but we're not doing that. We've corrected those problems. So I don't really think that is a legitimate...let me rephrase that, I think it's a legitimate question. I think Senator Lindsay is wrong on that particular portion of the question. And as Senator Horgan, I was glad that Senator Rasmussen said a couple of things. Senator Ashford was there crying foul, foul. If he had been in the British Parliament, he said he'd been throwing things at that particular time. Thank heavens, we are a little bit more sensible than the British Parliament. But families are not just parent and children. Senator Horgan's family may be that. Hopefully, other families are like that. Hopefully, my family is like that, but for the most part, families are very interrelated with lots of relationships, cousins, aunts, uncles, grandparents, relationships that children sometimes build upon one or another. And again, to get back to what I believe Senator Landis is trying to do that I support so much is that I want my child or someone else's child, if they are afraid of talking to their parent, afraid, and they are afraid of that court process, I want them to be able by law to talk to someone else. And if it is another family member, I can't guarantee, but I suggest the possibilities are high that that other family member will be saying things like, have you told your mom and dad, have you talked to them about it? The young child may come back and say, oh, I can't tell them, they'd be so embarrassed or I'm so embarrassed or they would kill me, whatever the case may be, and the aunt and uncle or the grandfather or grandmother may say, now, now, settle down, I know them, they are reasonable people, I'll go with you. And you're going to strengthen that family because they will be working together through someone they trust. It's not excluding anyone, Senator Horgan, it's including the real family which is everyone and I think we owe them at least that.
