SENATOR SCHROCK: I would...Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I would just make this pledge to Senator Warner. If we pass this bill in its present form, Senator Warner, I will not introduce any ethanol legislation next year.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, I'd be happy to move that we adjourn until Monday morning at 9:00 a.m.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adjourn. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. We are adjourned.
