And, if that is done, we will get 25 votes without a great amount of time. If you have any questions, there's no point in asking them, because I won't answer. It's obvious only I, the Pages, and a couple people under the balconies are listening. With that, I close and ask that you vote for this amendment, including the Speaker.

**SPEAKER BAACK:** Thank you, Senator Chambers. Any discussion on the Chambers amendment? Seeing none, we will now proceed to vote. Oops, Senator Crosby, on the Chambers amendment.

**SENATOR CROSBY:** I guess nobody is listening. But I'm just a little confused when you mentioned...I was trying to find the page, because I was going by the amendment in the Journal, and now I'm trying to look at the bill, Senator Chambers. Are we on 579? I'm looking at 569, that's the wrong bill. I don't understand what it has to do with conventions, I guess. What page is it on the bill?

**SENATOR CHAMBERS:** Well, Senator Crosby, on page 4...

**SENATOR CROSBY:** Of the bill, okay.

**SENATOR CHAMBERS:** Oh, wait a minute, page 6.

**SENATOR CROSBY:** Page 6?

**SENATOR CHAMBERS:** Uh-huh, line 7.

**SENATOR CROSBY:** Okay.
