

yourself back. You have got grandkids. You have got children. And I know as a former teacher, as I have always said, I know how kids are in school. This would not be important unless they really, really felt the need, and the need would not be there until they were in that position. So that is why I think this is even more important, in many ways, than the Withem amendment is. I am going to support it. I hope you will also. Thank you.

**SPEAKER BAACK:** Thank you, Senator Smith. Senator Labeledz.

**SENATOR LABEDZ:** Thank you. I just wanted to ensure each and every member of the Legislature that I am having an amendment drafted to also add to LB 425, the informed consent, because I strongly believe that if this information should be available, so should the unborn child's development, and that is informed consent. It is a bill that I strongly agree with Senator Lindsay on, and I am sorry he is not here, as I said before. But I believe that the information according to Senator Chambers, Senator Smith, and Senator Nelson, and Senator Hillman, that all this information should be available to the young pregnant lady, or the young girl. I think, also, the information on the unborn child's development or a film should be shown at that time, and all the alternatives to abortion, because somehow with this amendment, we have forgotten the unborn child and, evidently, with Senator Lindsay's amendment or Senator Lindsay's bill on informed consent, they will have all the information necessary, including the development of the child, the trauma of an abortion, the aftereffects. And because we have read horror stories where one girl in New York jumped off the bridge the day after she had an abortion because she couldn't take it any longer, not even 24 hours, and the parents of that young lady, I can't recall how much money was granted to her by the courts because she did not inform her parents that she was going to have an abortion. So, therefore, I think that if this amendment does pass, I will immediately get the amendment, possibly not be able to do it today, but it will be there, I assure you, on informed consent because of what Senator Chambers said and what Senator Will said and Senator Smith. And, incidentally, Senator Chambers, I don't know if you recall, but Senator Nelson insists on getting up and talking about the unfortunate situation of a pregnant girl, and at one time she even mentioned that if that child is born to a young lady and she has to go on ADC and on welfare, that just really upsets me, because, in other words, she is saying that if you are poor, you
