

and now I think this additional change about, it's at one time we count, not overall that you count, will also help clarify the situation and the Lamb amendment actually should already be the situation, but if it helps clarify it, that's fine. And so that's really where we're at. I hope I didn't confuse too much, but, Senator Smith, do you have a question for me? I'll let you have time.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Senator Wesely. He's giving me time. Just...Senator Wesely, stay at your mike because I wanted to ask you the question and I'll give you your time back again. What I would like to ask is, can you explain to us what would happen? It says no person shall furnish or offer or to furnish a program for four more children, you know. What if someone did it without becoming licensed or, I mean, when we say no person shall, what happens? Let's say a family, two families get together and they have five kids. What happens in a situation like that if this person does it and it says here no person shall? Do you have any provisions for that, is what I am asking you.

SENATOR WESELY: Right. Well, the department would come in and...but if you talk about five children, you're talking like one family has three, the other one has two?

SENATOR SMITH: Let's just say because of the way an amendment reads here, what happens if they have more than what we say they can do right here and they're not licensed? They haven't gone to be licensed. Does someone complain to the department and then the department checks into it? Is that how it works?

SENATOR WESELY: Okay. First off, let me use the example you gave though, five children, say three in one and two in the other. That would not fall under this. They would be able to do that without any sort of...

SENATOR SMITH: With this amendment?

SENATOR WESELY: No, this current status, this current situation. You wouldn't have to be licensed if you had three children in one family, two in the other, and you switched off and took care of their kids in some sort of fashion, so it's only if you have four or more children from outside your family that you're caring for that you trip the trigger and then have to be licensed. And if that's the case, then right now there
