CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hefner would move to amend the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, I would withdraw that at this time.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is withdrawn. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further pending to the budget bill at this time.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there discussion on the bill? Oh, excuse me, discussing the committee...these are the committee amendments. Discussion. Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I have actually read through this whole budget book the other night and, Senator Moore told me he was glad, but I do have a few questions that I would like to have for the record clarified. When I reached page 17, and I'm speaking now with Senator Moore if I might, I'd like to have a dialogue with him.
