

see the things listed on page 156 and then the totals are on page 157. Those are items that this Legislature had agreed to construct the last biennium. As those projects flow through the years, they are being completed this year and so we're actually paying for them. Basically, they were promised last year, we're paying for them now. So the reaffirmations in the bill are listed on page 156 and 157. Turn on to page 158 you will see, to begin with, there is three lines there of numbers, the first being the agency request; second being Governor's recommendation; third being committee's recommendation. I just wanted to mention the only things that are contained in this bill now are obviously the things under the committee's recommendation line. As you go through this book, you can see what those things are. I would like to mention that some people have asked me, are...is the Beadle Center in this bill? The answer to that is, no, that is in LB 760 and that is the cigarette tax bill and many of those new items of construction and large scale items are in the other capital construction bill, which will be LB 760 which we'll talk about at a later time. But 847, this is basically the reaffirmations and the cash funded things like in Game and Parks and also like to mention that the 309 money is indeed in this bill at the level of \$2 million. So, with that, I would move for advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the advancement of LB 847? Seeing none, Senator Moore, do you wish to close? Waives closing. We will now proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 847.
