SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Which is Child Protective Services.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Okay.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: So then what happens?

SENATOR LABEDZ: Any physician or attending physician who knowingly or intentionally performs...well, you don't want to know about that.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: No. Then she can go ahead and have the abortion.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Yes.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: If she goes home, then what happens as a result of that phone call to Child Protective Services?
