SENATOR WARNER: Motion pending is the adoption of the Wesely amendment. Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. It takes 25 votes. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment to the Lindsay amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: The motion is carried and the amendment is adopted. Are there further amendments on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Lindsay would move to amend his amendment. (Lindsay amendment appears on page 2210 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: I want to, first of all, thank you, Mr. Speaker. I want to first of all thank Senator Wesely for getting an invigorating debate going. I can't do that when my name is up on the board, but when the Wesely name is up there it happens. The amendment we have now before us would amend the amendment to add the county in, again, county and metropolitan, have a county and metropolitan class to add in a county into the deal and the idea is to make sure that the funds are there, if this deal does go through, that the funds, in fact, are available rather than having a, since they're going to be splitting the proceeds again. It is my understanding on the keno deal that the county I believe is getting 40 percent of the proceeds and the city gets 60 percent or something to that effect. So the intent is to allow the county also to be involved in that as far as getting some of the money involved. I'd urge the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Is there further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Lindsay, do you wish to close? Senator Lindsay waives closing. Those in favor of adoption of the Lindsay amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Clerk, record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Lindsay's amendment to his amendment.
