Are there further amendments?

CLERK: Nothing further pending to the Senator Lindsay's original amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR WARNER: Any further discussion on the adoption of amendment as amended by Senator Lindsay? There are no other lights.

SENATOR LINDSAY: I would simply urge the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: Those in favor of the adoption of the Lindsay amendment vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Mr. Speaker, or Mr. President, I guess, I would ask for a call of the house and I'll accept call ins.

SENATOR WARNER: Do I see five hands? I see five hands. Those in favor of a call of the house vote aye, opposed nay. Clerk, record.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR WARNER: Motion carried. The house is under call. Members will return to the Chamber. Those here check in, indicate your presence. Call in votes are accepted.

CLERK: Senator Robak voting yes.

SENATOR WARNER: Will members return to the Chamber. Those here, please check in.

CLERK: Senator Elmer voting yes. Senator Byars voting yes. Senator Warner voting no.

SENATOR WARNER: Clerk, record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Lindsay's amendment.

SENATOR WARNER: The amendment is adopted. Are there further amendments on the desk? Oh, yeah, raise the call. The call is raised.
