

services. Are those the private lines, what we may call a dedicated line for financial transfers, where you have a line that goes, let's say, from a merchant into a processing center. Those are those individual lines, is that your intent to do that?

SENATOR DIERKS: I think as far...if they're using interstate communications, yes.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Right. In other words, when we talk about private lines we're not talking about Senator Byars kids, when they have their private line, that's...this is for financial transfers, those are dedicated lines that do those sorts of things? To the best of my...I think that's what it says, but I want to make sure that I've got the right wording.

SENATOR DIERKS: Yes.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay. And then the next one is what's commonly known as the 800 and 900 services, but it also talks about a wide area of service, that's the WATS service, and so people in the body know, and correct me, Senator Dierks, if I'm wrong, but a lot of...your intent here was probably for telemarketers who may take a lot of those incoming calls, but a lot of telemarketers also do out calls, and they wouldn't necessarily dial 1-800. They would have their own lines and systems, and that's the reason you put in the Wide Area Transmission or Telecommunication Services?

SENATOR DIERKS: That's right.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay. Thank you very much. I think that there's also some question as to whether that would raise \$10 million or not. I think the figure might be a little closer to 7 with those exceptions out of there. And I know that Senator Dierks is trying to take those from existing Revenue Committee plans. And Senator Hall maybe will want to talk about those sorts of things. But I would really urge the body to be careful with industry specific replacement, because you're going to wind up with one industry who gets hit with all four of these sorts of things, and that's what got us in the problem to begin with. What we're looking for is a short-term, until we can find the long-term solution. These things have a way of making their way into the long-term solution, just by being the only answer.
