LB 616, 619

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the readvancement of LB 619 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Heard the motion to readvance. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. LB 619 is readvanced.

CLERK: Madam President, the next motion I have is by Senator Conway. Senator Conway would move to return LB 616 to Select File for a specific amendment. Senator, I have AM2256 in front of me. (See AM2256 on page 2807 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President and members. This, LB 616, is the judicial districts for the Supreme Court districts. What we found, and we found this in several areas, in many cases it was very difficult to draw the language and this should be also in that three-page packet that you have, several examples of difficulty in terms of getting the language to conform to the map, and as we got to looking at the map, and to find its form, we found it on Pacific Street in Omaha, that even if we talked about Pacific Street running from the, let's say, 20th to 50th Street on Pacific that Pacific Street doesn't run from 20th to 50th. There's a little park somewhere around 30th Street, in that area, and so, therefore, to be technically accurate, we need to describe around that little park and that's where Turner Boulevard southeast and northwest on Turner back to Pacific comes into play. So really what it is, a little tiny bubble. It's about a half a block turnout but actually Pacific doesn't go through and so, therefore, in order to make it perfectly accurate and not describe Pacific Street in that reach from 20th to 50th or whatever it would be, this is simply to make it technically correct so that it goes around that park because Pacific doesn't go through. So it's simply a very minor adjustment to that, but it will make it technically correct, so I ask the body to return LB 616 for this specific amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. Does anyone wish to speak to this motion? Seeing none, we'll now vote on the motion to return 616. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to return? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, to return LB 616 to Select File.
