

whether we're going to adopt this or not, I think it more consistently maintains the integrity of the 1st District and the 3rd District as we now know them. And I would urge you to adopt this, readvance the bill to Final Reading and then make up your own mind on the Conway plan.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Withem. We will now vote on the Withem amendment. I remind the senators that the house is under call. Would Senators Robak, Smith, please return to the chambers so we can proceed with the vote. We shouldn't have to check in again. The house has been under call.

SENATOR MOORE: But are we waiting for someone?

PRESIDENT MOUL: Had to leave, I believe.

SENATOR MOORE: Point of order. Usually in this circumstance we ask someone to check in, that would be a legitimate request to have everyone check in. Other than that, we should record the vote, I would think.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: I must agree with Senator Moore. For procedural purposes, I don't think we need to sit around and wait. If I want other people here, I would ask for a check in and I am formally at this point asking for all members to punch their buttons and check in. If that request could not be granted, I'd be interested in knowing the reason why.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Would the senators please check in. We are looking for Senator Robak. We'll now proceed with the vote on the Withem amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Hefner requesting record vote. (Record vote read. See page 2809 of the Legislative Journal.) 26 ayes, 20 nays, Madam President, on adoption of the Select File amendment as offered by Senator Withem.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move for the readvancement of LB 615 to E & R for engrossment.
