

January 13, 1992 LB 859, 860, 861

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, LB 859 repeals a section of the Public Accountancy Act of 1957 which required the revisor of statutes to substitute a phrase, Public Accountancy Act, if appropriate and this session it directed the revisor to substitute those terms, has now been implemented and so it is obsolete and can be removed from the statute. I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Is there anyone who wishes to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 859. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 859.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 859 has advanced. LB 860.

CLERK: 860. Madam President, offered by Senator Warner as chairperson of the Board. (Title read.) The bill was introduced on January 8, referred directly to General File.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Madam President, members of the Legislature, LB 860, first, the legislation enacted in 1981 that directed the revisor of statutes to substitute the words "Department of Health" for the "State Board of Health". That has now been completed so the section that had that directive is no longer needed and is obsolete. Move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Warner. Is there anyone who wishes to speak to this bill? Seeing none, we will now vote on the motion to advance LB 860. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 860.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 860 is advanced. LB 861.

CLERK: 861, introduced by Senator Warner, chairperson of the Exec. Board. (Title read.) The bill was introduced on
