Dierks' closing on the advancement of LB 522. We will now vote on the advancement. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 522. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? We are voting on the advancement of 522. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk. A record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 421-22 of the Legislative Journal.) 27 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 522.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 522 advances. Yes.

CLERK: Very quickly, Mr. President, Referencing Committee will meet now in Room 2102, Referencing Committee now in Room 2102. That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now proceed to LB 522A.

CLERK: 522A was a bill introduced by Senator Dierks. (Read title.) It was introduced on May 7 of last year. Mr. President, I do have an amendment from Senator Dierks to the bill. Senator, AM2466 in front of me. (Amendment appears on page 422 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Dierks, on the amendment.

SENATOR DIERKS: What's the dollar amount in this bill, Pat?

CLERK: On Section 1, Senator, I've got \$84,620. Do you see that number?

SENATOR DIERKS: What about Section 2?

CLERK: Section 2, \$96,600.

SENATOR DIERKS: Okay. Mr. Speaker, members of the body, this latest amendment brings into effect the amendments that is Senator Chizek's amendment to the bill so that the dollar amount now would read from \$105,600 down to \$96,600 to the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund and it repeats that figure in the next sentence. So that's where the change is. It brings the total amount of the A bill from 105,600 to 96,600 and I would ask for your approval to send that on to Select.
