SENATOR SCHMIT: Well, Senator Nelson, I have reviewed the amendment after visiting with Mr. Winston, and his explanation to me is that it is a technical amendment suggested by the bill drafter. I just received it this morning, a few minutes ago, and he assures me there is nothing hidden in it. We will have some...an amendment to the next amendment because of some disagreements within that amendment. But, as nearly as I can tell, and I take Mr. Winston's word for it, they are honorable people down there in the General Affairs Committee, and there is nothing hidden there, and I know that Senator Schellpeper would not do that also. So again I want to reassure you.

SENATOR NELSON: Thanks a lot.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Nelson. Anyone else wishing to discuss the amendment by Senator Schmit? Seeing no one, Senator Schmit, did you wish to close?
