SENATOR CHAMBERS: Otherwise, the county would pay the fee? Is that what we're being told?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Right, correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wickersham, can you...if you...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would be glad to answer that question. What was it?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wickersham.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers had a question and I tried to clear it up. Did I suit your language that you wanted? Senator Chambers' concern was that the person would not be charged twice.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Should I ask him the question, Senator Cudaback?
